Advent

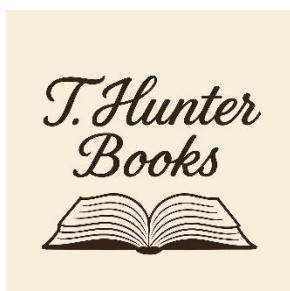
